## NOTABLE CASES

I have prosecuted a number of murders (and prosecuted various attempted murders unled), notably:

R v Dickinson (the longest and most complex single defendant murder case tried on the Northern Circuit).

R v Iqbal - attempted murder of inconvenient girlfriend by driving car at her.

I have defended in many complex trials, for example

R v Turner (internet grooming of adolescent girls followed by their abduction and rape).

R v Hussain (drug dealing and alleged rape of addict).

Health & Safety cases include:

R v Ellis Teacher who supervised a fatal plunge pool expedition - conviction of manslaughter.

R v Blackpool Bus and Tram Company - death of a bus driver knocked down at bus depot breach Health & Safety regulations
