*A British national accused of murdering a Pakistani national in Pakistan.*

*An identity fraud causing members of the public to suffer losses of millions of pounds.*

*Local Authority electoral frauds.*

*Forced importation of women from Eastern Europe and requiring them to work as prostitutes in the North West.*

*Large-scale conspiracy to bring into the United Kingdom illegal immigrants from the Indian subcontinent via South African with the participation and assistance of employees of the South African Home Office.*

*The abduction of Shannon Matthews*

*Defended in a number of multi-handed grooming cases*

*Represented the Manager of a Hugo Boss store (Bicester Village) at an Inquest concerning the death of a child who died as result of an accidental fall of a mirror upon him.*
