

Diversity Questionnaire – 2020

In July 2020 Lincoln House Chambers invited members and staff to respond to a diversity questionnaire.

Chambers comprises 90 people, which includes 16 QCs, 59 junior barristers, 2 pupils and 13 employees.

83 people responded to the questionnaire, representing 92% of chambers' personnel. 7 people did not respond to the questionnaire.

77 respondents (93.9%) explicitly consented to the processing and publication of their data as set out in the questionnaire and the Lincoln House Chambers' Diversity Data Policy. 6 respondents (6.1%) did not consent.

64 respondents (78.05%) explicitly consented to the processing and publication of their data in an anonymous form, even if there were fewer than 10 individuals identified against one or more of the characteristics. 19 respondents (21.95%) did not consent. Accordingly, not all of the data obtained has been reproduced in this report and so the data below does not give an entirely accurate view of diversity within chambers.

To assist the reader understand the diversity of chambers in context the questionnaire results have been set out to reflect the following three groups:





Q2 What is your role in Lincoln House Chambers?













Q7 Are your day-to-day activities limited or affected by a health problem or disability that has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?









Q10 What is your sexual orientation?







Q12 Did you mainly attend a state or fee paying school between the ages 11 - 18?





Q13 If you attended university, were you part of the first generation of your family to do so?











Q2 What is your role in Lincoln House Chambers?













Q7 Are your day-to-day activities limited or affected by a health problem or disability that has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?









Q10 What is your sexual orientation?







Q12 Did you mainly attend a state or fee paying school between the ages 11 - 18?





Q13 If you attended university, were you part of the first generation of your family to do so?





Q14 If you attended university, what kind of university did you attend?









Q3 How old are you?





Q4 What best describes your gender?









Q7 Are your day-to-day activities limited or affected by a health problem or disability that has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?







Q9 What is your religion or belief system?









Q12 Did you mainly attend a state or fee paying school between the ages 11 - 18?







Q14 If you attended university, what kind of university did you attend?




